



Here are the 12 easy steps to the official dance for National School Choice Week 2020.

Download this year's song, 'Best Day' by Loomin, free from our website at

www.schoolchoiceweek.com/dance

Step 1

Step to your right, touch behind, cross arms in front and snap fingers at your side.
Repeat 7 times, side to side.

Step 2

Slide to your left, slide to your right while floating your arms out to the sides.

Step 3

Make a three step turn to your left with airplane arms then jump and clap.

Step 4

Repeat steps 2 & 3 on the other side.
Slide to your right, then slide to your left and float your arm out to the side.
Make a three step turn to your left with airplane arms then jump and clap.

Step 5

Point hand and foot right, cross in front. Point left, cross in front.

Step 6

With arms behind your back, cross step in front, step back, step to the side, jump and clap.

Step 7

Repeat steps 5 & 6 on the other side.
Point hand and foot left, cross in front, and point right, cross in front.
With arms behind your back, cross step in front, step back, step to the side, jump and clap.

Step 8

Now punch up to your right, step behind, punch up to your left, step behind and step to the four corners.

Do this step twice.

Step 9

Turn to face left, step-touch-snap to the front, step-touch-snap to the back. Turn, jump and clap.

Step 10

Repeat on the other side.

Turn to face right, step-touch-snap to the front, step-touch-snap to the back. Turn, jump and clap.

Step 11

Wave your scarf in the air, side to side, 6 times. Put your scarf back on.

Now start again at step 1 and repeat the whole dance sequence again until the end of the song.

That's it! Remember, if these moves are confusing to you, feel free to improvise, come up with your own moves to make this dance your own!
