

ACTIVITY IDEAS

FOR HOMESCHOOL GROUPS

1. Host an information session or open house for prospective homeschool parents to explain what they can expect if they choose to educate their children in the home.
2. Combine fun and learning with free, printable activity sheets and decorations.

3. Plan a poster or essay contest for homeschooled students, and host an awards ceremony or publish the winning submissions in your local newspaper.
4. Arrange a display of art projects created by talented homeschooled students.
5. Set up a meeting with a local elected official, such as a mayor, and explain how homeschooling benefits the community.
6. Have students design and complete a community service project, take pictures, and share the project online.
7. Have students fill out our "I Love Homeschooling" placards, and share photos of the students holding these placards online. Tag us using #schoolchoice.
8. Students can learn and perform the NSCW dance and then film it, upload it to YouTube, and tag us using #schoolchoice. Watch the tutorial at www.schoolchoiceweek.com/dance.
9. Have a "Yellow Day" on which students and teachers wear yellow clothing or accessories. Or have a "Spirit Week" with a different theme each day.
10. Plan a poetry night at a local venue where students can share their talents and connect with other students.
11. Plan a local field trip for all the homeschooled students in your region.
12. Host a talent show for students and staff to show off their skills.
13. Conduct interviews on local radio or television stations to promote homeschooling.
14. Hold a community potluck or coffee morning to share the benefits of school choice and homeschooling.
15. Host a family game night with homeschooling families and members of the community interested in learning about school choice.
16. Have students complete an indoor or outdoor scavenger hunt. Find free lists on our site at schoolchoiceweek.com/printables.
17. Have students make and share a quick video about why they love being homeschooled. Consider having parents submit a video sharing why they chose to homeschool their children. Tag us using #schoolchoice.
