nonpublic schools from which parents can choose for their children, in addition to families who educate their children in the

home; and

WHEREAS, educational variety not only helps to diversify our economy, but

also enhances the vibrancy of our community; and

WHEREAS Louisiana has many high-quality teaching professionals in all

types of school settings who are committed to educating our

children; and

WHEREAS School Choice Week is celebrated across the country by millions of

students, parents, educators, schools and organizations to raise

awareness of the need for effective educational options; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Landry, Governor of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim

January 26- February 1, 2025 as

Louisiana School Choice Week

and I call this observance to the attention of all our citizens.
