Whereas, South Dakota has many high-quality teaching professionals in all types of school settings who are committed to educating our children; and,



Whereas, School Choice Week is celebrated across the country by millions of students, parents, educators, schools and organizations to raise awareness of the need for effective educational options:


Now, Therefore, I, Larry Rhoden, Governor of the State of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim January 25, 2026, as

School Choice Week


in South Dakota.
