WHEREAS, educational variety not only helps to diversify our economy, but also enhances the vibrancy of our community; and


WHEREAS, Iowa has many high-quality teaching professionals in all types of school settings who are committed to educating our children; and

WHEREAS, School Choice Week is celebrated across the country by millions of students, parents, educators, schools and organizations to raise awareness of the need for effective educational options:


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kim Reynolds, Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim January 25th–31st, 2026 as:
