WHEREAS, Mississippi has many high-quality teaching professionals in all types of school settings who are committed to educating our children; and

WHEREAS, research demonstrates that providing children with multiple educational options can improve academic performance; and

WHEREAS, School Choice Week is celebrated across the country by millions of students, parents, educators, schools, and organizations to raise awareness of the need for effective educational options.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tate Reeves, Governor of the State of Mississippi, do hereby proclaim January 25 - 31, 2026, as

and call this observance to the attention of all of our residents.
